TWIST is an organization dedicated to community improvement by enhancing the lives of others through volunteer service and is committed to developing and enriching our community through interaction and teamwork.

This year TWIST is offering community service scholarships to graduating seniors who plan to attend college or trade school. Scholarships, in the amount of up to \$1,000.00, will be awarded to students who exemplify the TWIST ideals of community involvement and improvement, with an emphasis on Tuolumne Township area community service.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicants must live in the Tuolumne Township area
- An accumulative grade point average of 2.0 or greater (School administration will verify)
- · Applicants must use funds to attend a trade school or college

Application Requirements:


- Applicants must submit a completed standard Summerville Scholarship application or attached student profile.
- Applicants must submit two letters of recommendation. Letters may not be from relatives and preferably be from a community member and an instructor.
- Applicants must submit, on separate sheet, an essay of 500 words or more, on one of the following topics:
 - Describe your most meaningful experience in the Tuolumne Township community and how you will use what you have learned for the future.
 - 2. What are some of the values you have learned from the people of Tuolumne Township? Give some specific examples.
 - 3. Based on what you have learned from your community service, how do you see yourself contributing to your community?
- Applicants must submit, on a separate sheet, a list of community service directly related to the town of Tuolumne, with a brief description of each item.

Application Deadline:

Applications must be submitted to the school principal or grade level coordinator before
<u>Friday, March 22,2024</u>, or received in the mail by that date: PO Box 223, Tuolumne CA
95379

The scholarship committee will review submitted applications by early April. Personal interviews may be required. Every effort will be made to make interview times convenient for applicants. Scholarship recipients will be notified of awards in late May. Funds will be dispersed upon proof of registration at college or trade school, and must be requested by March 20, 2025.
